In Rural Zambia there are not enough schools, with no school accessible to the village children in the Nsobe area of the Copperbelt. Ninety percent of our children's parents are illiterate and live way below the poverty line. To offer hope and the chance of an educated future Nsobe community School was started in 2009. 2024 will see us with 650 children in 12 Grades, from Reception to Grade 12, taught by 34 dedicated teachers plus supporting staff.

Over 50% of children in rural schools do not pass into higher secondary school. Nsobe Community School ensures a high standard of education and a great foundation that demands a 100% pass rate, and a chance to attend tertiary studies or vocational training. Your donation will help vulnerable rural children ensure a future that will lead to jobs, wealth creation and eventually a chance to feed back into the Zambian economy.

All of our pupils are poor, many are undernourished, most sleep on a dirt floor. There is no water or electricity. Drunkenness, witchcraft, neglect and abuse are rife.

A cherished a protected childhood, usually taken as a given in the UK, is missed out on. School is seen as a refuge and a place of love and hope where children are cared for and encouraged by their teachers. Their education is an opportunity that is passionately grasped, children walking long distances to attend class with commitment.
